

No Less than 687 Cases of Arbitrary Arrest in September 2018

Coalition member SNHR found that approximately 687 individuals were arbitrarily arrested in Syria in September 2018. The report notes that the Syrian regime is responsible for 87% of all arbitrary arrests, and urges the UN Security Council and the UN Human Rights Council to address the issue of enforced-disappearances.
